The BAT Design Team, working closely with neuroscience specialists, have created a Table Tennis table specifically devised to enhance the Table Tennis Therapeutic Experience for those living with Alzheimer's.



Creating Contrast

The clinical white table playing surface utilised with bright balls, enhances contrast to assist sight and perception. The extended borders emphasise perspective and aid visual field map organisation.

Longer Focused Activity

The attached side panels increase spatial awareness, creating a secure, non-distracting and comforting play zone, while enhancing peripheral vision by keeping the balls on the table and in play for longer duration.

Social Flourishing

Table tennis trumps most other types of exercise intervention by being a social activity that promotes joy and laughter between individuals – be they young or old, healthy or infirm, sitting or standing.

Sustainable Therapy

Just one BAT Therapy Table can provide a truly positive therapeutic impact; not just short term, to an individual – but long term, to an entire care community.

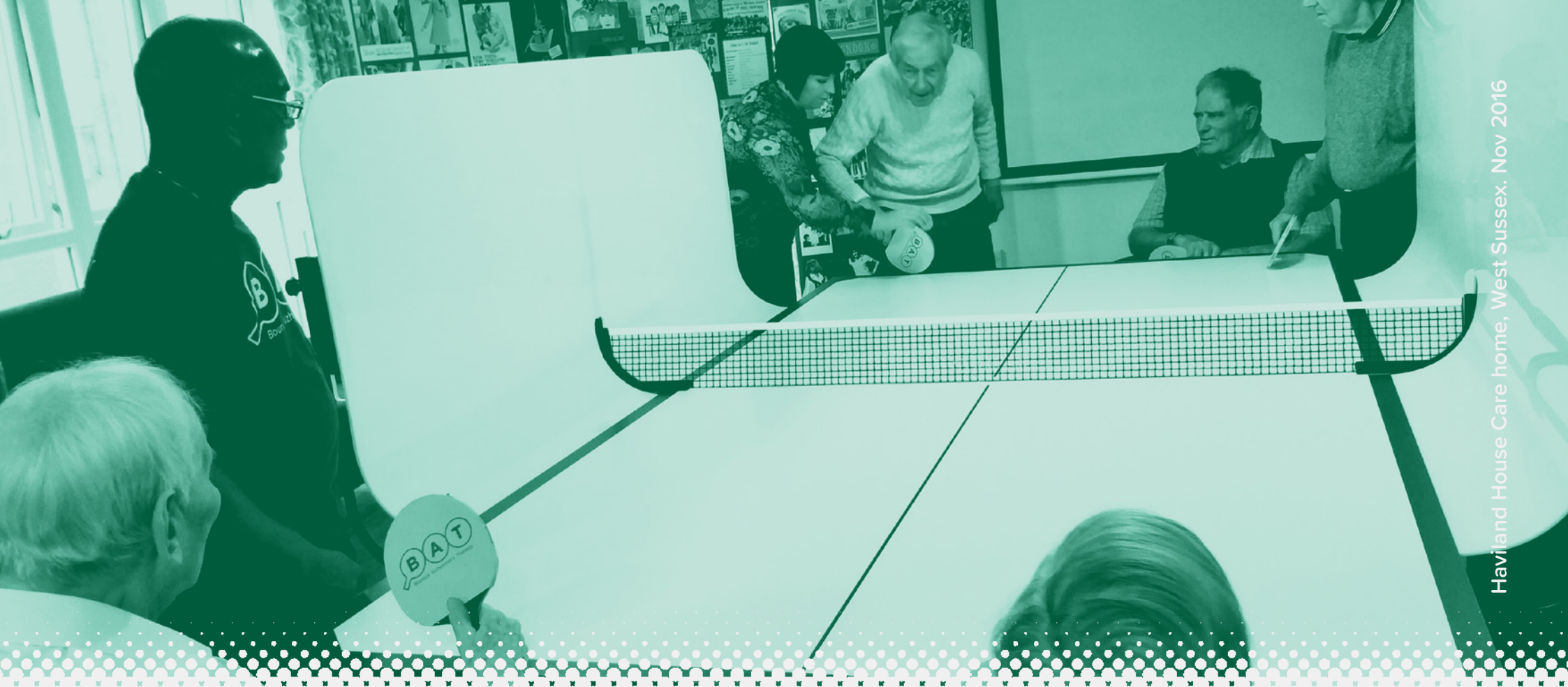
